Zie hieronder kort een overzicht van de Iraanse berichtgeving rondom buitenlandse betrokkenheid bij de aanslagen in Ahwaz van afgelopen weekend.

- The Danish Foreign Ministry spokesperson Soeren Espersen was quoted by Iranian media as saying (in talking to the Danish Radio) that if it receives (from Iran) evidence proving Iran's allegation that members of Al-Ahwaz terrorist group living in Denmark were in fact involved/ were behind the Saturday's attack in Ahwaz, then Denmark would extradite the offenders to Iran for prosecution.
- The Supreme Leader, Ayatollah Khamenei, said that the hands of those committed the terrorist attacks in Ahwaz on Saturday are in the pockets of the Saudi Arabia and the UAE. He also said that those who shed the bloods of innocent Iranians the other day will meet the harshest consequences and punishment for their heinous acts
- Keyhan recycled a news from Saturday and said Ambassadors of Denmark and the Netherlands expressed willingness to research members of Al-Ahwaz group – they quoted the Head of Foreign Ministry's representative office in Khuzestan province, referring to the summoning of the Dutch and Danish ambassadors by the Foreign Ministry and said the two Ambassadors informed the Ministry of the willingness of their governments for exchange of information and cooperation that could help finding out about the background of Al-Ahwaz terrorist group¹.
